A Sins receive their aggravations, 1. From the persons offending: 1 if they be of riper age, 2 greater experience or grace,³ eminent for profession,⁴ gifts,⁵ place,⁶ office,⁷ guides to others,⁸ and whose example is likely to be followed by others.⁹ 2.
