A Christ humbled himself in his death, in that having been betrayed by Judas,<sup>1</sup> forsaken by his disciples,<sup>2</sup> scorned and rejected by the world,<sup>3</sup> condemned by Pilate, and tormented by his persecutors;<sup>4</sup> having also conflicted with the terrors of death, and the powers of darkness, felt and borne the weight of God's wrath,<sup>5</sup> he laid down his life an offering for sin,<sup>6</sup> enduring the painful, shameful, and cursed death of the cross.<sup>7</sup>
